SECTION - 1

GENERAL INFORMATION

1-1 Intent

It is the intent of this bid to establish a contract(s) for the supply and delivery of School and Office Furniture to the Carroll County Board of Education, also known as Carroll County Public Schools (CCPS), for the contract period pending availability of funds.

1-2 Carroll County Public Schools / Carroll County Board of Education

While Carroll County Public Schools (CCPS) is the actual entity and the Board of Education of Carroll County (BOECC) is the contracting authority, for the purpose of this solicitation, Carroll County Public Schools (CCPS) and the Board of Education of Carroll County (BOECC) will be used interchangeably, and will mean one and the same thing.

1-3 Background

Carroll County Public Schools has 40 schools and a total enrollment of approximately 25,000 students. By category, CCPS has seven (7) high schools; eight (8) middle schools; twenty-two (22) elementary schools; and three (3) alternative education schools.

1-4 Delivery

Delivery and set-up will be made to any facility in the Carroll County Public School System. All items must be delivered inside between the hours of 8:30 AM and 3:00 PM, excluding school holidays. Setup will include: placement into the room as designated by the Purchase Order (or by the Principal and/or his/her designee); unpacking of furniture; complete assembly; any adjustments; and removal of packing material. Notification and scheduling of delivery with the receiving school or office at least twenty four (24) hours prior to delivery is required.

1-5 Errors In Bids

Bidders or their authorized representatives are expected to inform themselves as to the conditions, requirements and specifications before they submit bids; failure to do so will be at the bidder's own risk and he cannot secure relief from the plea of error. Neither law nor regulations make allowance for errors either of omission or commission on the part of bidders. In case of error in extension of prices in the bid, the unit price shall govern.

1-6 Quantities

Actual order quantities are unknown at this time. It is the intent for CCPS schools and offices to use this bid for purchases of the specified items throughout the term of this contract.

1-7 Bid Pricing

All unit prices must remain firm during the contract period and <u>shall include all delivery costs</u>. No proposal shall be considered which contains an escalator clause, packaging or delivery charges, or any add on or irregular figures. A separate price must be offered for each item bid; bids for "all or none" will not be considered. Please bid only one (1) price for each item. In cases where two different items are bid, both items may be rejected. Vendors do not need to bid on all items.

Price decreases from the manufacturer are required to be passed along. Failure to do so will be viewed as having not executed the contract in good faith, which may result in cancellation of the contract. Problems occurring solely as a result of vendor error must be remedied by the vendor at no cost to the school or office.

Vendors are requested to supply a percentage discount off of catalog list prices. This catalog discount is for all items within the catalog that are not specifically listed on the bid and will remain in effect through the entire contract period. Any exceptions to this percentage discount must be provided with the bid submittal.

Any minimum order requirement, be it dollar amount or unit quantity, must be specified in the bid response in the appropriate area.

1-8 Compliance with Specifications

The contractor shall abide by and comply with the true intent of specifications and not take advantage of any unintentional error or omission, but shall fully complete every part of the true intent and meaning of the specifications, as decided by the Board of Education.

All parts of the invitation to bid and the information for bidder shall become a part of the specifications. It is the intent of the specifications to provide complete information on all items specified; any omissions, errors, conflicts or discrepancies in the specifications shall be called to the attention of the Contact / Contract Administration listed in item 1-21 of this section.

1-9 Taxes

No charges will be allowed for federal, state, or municipal sales and excise taxes, from which the Board of Education is exempt. The price bid shall be net and shall not include the amount of any such tax. This does not exempt bidder from paying proper taxes but only indicates that Board of Education shall not be charged tax on final bid price(s).

1-10 Product

The use of the name of manufacturer or of any special brand or make in describing any items in this bid does not restrict bidders to the manufacturer or brand and make unless specifically stated "no substitution". The reference thereto is descriptive of the character and quality desired.

Bidders offering any article other than as specified must so state in each instance. Otherwise, their bid will be considered as being based upon furnishing the specific make, brand or manufacturer named in the bid.

Successful vendors will receive purchase orders for each requirement from various locations within the Carroll County Public School System during the contract period. In the event the manufacturer replaces the specified product(s) with a new product, the bidder must notify the Purchasing Office in writing, and will apprize Carroll County Public Schools of product replacement options at the contract price, and/or any cost reductions available for the specified product(s). Carroll County Public Schools reserves the right to authorize such product replacement (prior to any delivery of the item) and/or cost reduction on any specified products

Catalog cuts including product photograph(s), product specifications and warranty terms <u>must</u> accompany bids for all items, even if it is specified. <u>It is the bidder's responsibility to supply</u> <u>information and proof that the item(s) bid meets all specifications</u>. The item specification sheet(s) must be legible and clearly marked with the vendor name and CCPS item number for identification. <u>Failure to include a conforming catalog cut of any item may result in rejection of the item(s)</u>.

Carroll County Public Schools will be the sole evaluator in determining item specification compliance and "alternate/or equal" conformance to acceptable CCPS quality standards for all bids submitted.

1-11 Samples

Samples may be requested for evaluation purposes. Bidder shall forward samples within three working days of the request. <u>Samples must be clearly labeled with the name of bidder and manufacturer,</u> <u>make, and model; bid number, and bid item number</u>.</u> Samples may be returned if arrangements are made by the bidder. Any sample not claimed by June 30, 2023 will become property of the Board of Education.

1-12 Bid Submittal

Two copies of the proposal must be submitted in a sealed envelope to the Purchasing Department, Room 214, Carroll County Public Schools, 125 North Court Street, Westminster, MD 21157-5193, <u>not</u> <u>later than May 5, 2023, 11:00 A.M. local time</u>, at which time they will be publicly opened. Bids received after this date and time will be returned unopened and will not be considered. Faxed bid responses will not be accepted.

Bidders shall identify their bid envelope with the bidder's name and clearly marked <u>Bid #23-046P</u> <u>School and Office Furniture.</u>

1-13 Basis for Award

This bid shall be awarded to the low responsible and responsive bidder(s) meeting specifications on a line item basis, or group basis, whichever is in the best interest of CCPS. Bids shall be evaluated on factors to include, but not limited to price, item offered, quality/durability, past vendor performance, minimum order requirements, manufacturer's warranty and compliance with the bid requirements. <u>Carroll County Public Schools reserves the right to make a single or multiple award for each line item</u>. Carroll County Public Schools shall be the sole judge as to whether items meet specifications or are an approved equal, and further reserves the right to reject any or all proposals or to waive any informality which may be in the best interest of CCPS.

1-14 Bidder Qualifications

Bidder shall have been a regular dealer in the product offered for a period of not less than two (2) years from date of issuance of this bid.

1-15 Addenda

All changes to the bid specification will be made through the appropriate addenda. The addenda form shall be completed and returned with the bid proposal response. Failure to return the addenda may be reason for rejection of the bid. CCPS Purchasing Department will issue addenda to the bidders who are on record. It is, however, every bidder's responsibility to acquire all addenda.

1-16 Responsibility for Supplies Tendered

The contractor shall be responsible for the materials or supplies covered by this contract until they are delivered at the designated point, and the contractor shall bear all risk on rejected materials or supplies after notice of rejection. Rejected materials or supplies must be removed by and at the expense of the contractor promptly after notification of rejection. Upon failure to do so within ten (10) days after date of notification of rejection, the Board of Education may return the rejected materials or supplies to the contractor at his risk and expense.

1-17 Documentation

All deliveries must be accompanied by a delivery ticket. The contractor must obtain a signature on the delivery receipt for all items delivered. The contractor will be required to furnish proof of delivery in every instance.

1-18 Inspections

Inspections and acceptance of materials or supplies will be made after delivery at the destination herein specified unless otherwise stated. If inspection is made after delivery at destination herein specified, the Board of Education will bear the expense of inspection except for the value of samples used in case of rejection. Final inspection shall be conclusive except as regards to latent defects, fraud, or such gross mistakes as amount to fraud. Final inspections and acceptance or rejection of the materials or supplies will be made as promptly as practicable, but failures to inspect and accept or reject materials or supplies shall not impose liability on the Board for such materials or supplies as are not in accordance with the specifications.

1-19 Billing and Payment

Each invoice shall carry the CCPS purchase order number, and the items shall be listed in the same order as on the purchase order. Invoices must be submitted in duplicate to CCPS, Attention: Accounts Payable. Payment will be made only upon final acceptance by CCPS. Partial shipments will be accepted but invoices will not be approved for payment until all articles on any given purchase order are delivered and accepted. The cash discount period shall date from the receipt of the invoice and not from the date of the invoice. Payment cannot be arranged until 20 days after complete delivery of items on a given order.

1-20 Optional Use of Contract

Unless specifically prohibited by the bidder, the following entities within Maryland shall have the option to order from this contract:

- 1. Carroll County Government, Towns & Fire Departments
- 2. Carroll County Community College
- 3. Private and Parochial Schools within Carroll County
- 4. Any Maryland County Public School

SECTION 2

TERMS and CONDITIONS

2-1 Contract

The Board of Education of Carroll County will enter into a contract with the successful bidder (s) using the Board of Education of Carroll County standard purchase order. The contract shall incorporate all of the terms and conditions of the Invitation to Bid including all provisions, attachments, and any addenda that are issued.

2-2 Contract Period

Pricing shall commence on July 1, 2023, pending approval by the Board of Education and remain in effect until June 30, 2024. All pricing must remain firm for the duration of the contract period. Successful vendors will receive purchase orders for exact requirements from various locations within the Carroll County Public School System.

2-3 Warranty and Recall

The furniture or equipment item shall carry a minimum of one-year warranty against defects in parts and workmanship. Clearly stating the manufacturer warranty terms and conditions for each item offered will be of benefit to the bidder when CCPS determines bid awards. CCPS must be notified of any manufacturer recalls that you are made aware of.

2-4 Insurance

The Contractor shall purchase and maintain such insurance as will protect him, and the Board of Education of Carroll County (CCPS) from claims which may arise out of or result from the Contractor's operations under the contract, whether such operations be by himself or by any subcontractor, lower tier contractor or by anyone directly or indirectly employed by any of them, or by anyone for whom acts any of them may be liable.

A Certificate of Insurance must be submitted to the CCPS verifying that the Contractor maintains Worker's Compensation, General Liability and Automobile Liability coverage prior to commencement of work. The Certificate of Insurance must list CCPS, 125 North Court Street, Westminster, MD 21157 as Certificate Holder and as an additional Insured for General Liability and any other applicable coverage.

The Contractor shall notify CCPS in writing at least thirty (30) days prior to any changes or cancellation of any insurance policies.

Coverage Requirements:

- a. Worker's Compensation Statutory requirements
- b. **Employer's Liability** Statutory Limits \$100,000. each accident \$100,000. disease each employee \$500.000. disease policy limit
- c. General Liability
 - 1. **Bodily Injury and property damage** \$1,000,000. each occurrence \$2,000,000. aggregate

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2. **Products and Completed Operations** \$2,000,000. aggregate Products and Completed Operations Insurance shall be maintained for a minimum period of two (2) years after final payment, and the Contractor shall continue to provide a Certificate of Insurance listing the BOECC as Certificate Holder as evidence of such coverage.

- 3.Personal and Advertising Injury\$1,000,000. each occurrence
- d. Automobile Bodily Injury and Property Damage \$1,000,000. each accident
- e. Umbrella \$2,000,000. each occurrence and aggregate

2-5 Indemnification

To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Successful Bidder shall indemnify Carroll County Board of Education and Carroll County Public Schools and its officials, employees and agents from and against all claims, liens, or demands that result in losses, liabilities, defense costs and expenses (including, but not limited to attorneys' fees and costs of litigation) arising out of the terms, conditions, and performance of this contract.

2-6 Laws, Permits And Ordinance, Etc.

The contractor shall comply with all laws and ordinances, local or state, and shall be responsible for any and all accidents that may occur to all persons in connections with his work. All permits of any kind shall be procured by the contractor and where cost is attached, pay for same.

2-7 Tobacco Free and Alcohol/Drug Free Environment

The Carroll County Public School System maintains a tobacco, alcohol/drug free environment. The sale or use of tobacco, alcohol or drugs, in any form, or related product, is prohibited in school buildings at all times. Persons found violating this policy will be requested to remove the product and themselves from school premises.

2-8 Termination for Convenience

The performance of work under this contract may be terminated by the Board of Education in accordance with this clause in whole, or from time to time in part, whenever the Board of Education shall determine that such termination is in the best interest of the Board of Education.

Written notice will be given at least thirty (30) days in advance. The Board of Education will pay for all labor and material in accordance with Bid Price up to the date of the termination. However, the contractor shall not be reimbursed for any anticipatory profits which have not been earned up to the date of termination.

2-9 Termination for Default:

The Board of Education of Carroll County may, by written notice of default to the contractor, terminate the whole or any part of the contract in any one of the following circumstances:

a. If the contractor fails to make the delivery of supplies or equipment exactly as specified or perform the services within the time and manner specified therein or any extension thereof, or:

- b. If the contractor fails to perform any of the provisions of this contract, or fails to make progress as to endanger performance of this contract in accordance with its terms and in either of these two (2) circumstances does not cure such failure within a period of ten (10) calendar days (or such longer period as the Supervisor of Purchasing may authorize in writing) after receipt of written notice from the Supervisor of Purchasing specifying such time failure or:
- c. If the contractor willfully attempts to make delivery of items other than the items in the contract or perform the services other than specified as to quality, contents of pack, work processes or otherwise without specified authorization in the form of a contract amendment, or:
- d. If a determination is made by the Board of Education of Carroll County that the obtaining of the contract was influenced by an employee of the Carroll County Public School System having received a gratuity, or a promise thereof, of any way or form.

In the event the Board of Education terminates this contract in whole or in part, the Board of Education may procure such items and in such a manner as the Supervisor of Purchasing may deem appropriate, supplies and services similar to those so terminated, and the contractor shall be liable to the Board of Education for any excess cost for such similar supplies or services provided that the contractor shall continue the performance of the contract to the extent not terminated.

If, after notice of termination of this contract under the provisions of this clause, it is determined for any reason that the contractor was not in default under the provisions of this clause, or that the default was excusable under the provisions of this clause, the rights and obligations of the parties shall be the same as if the notice of termination had been issued pursuant to a Termination for Convenience.

2-10 Governing Law and Venue

This contract is subject to and will be construed and interpreted under the laws of the state of Maryland. All lawsuits arising out of such contracts shall be filed in the Circuit Court of Carroll County, Maryland.

2-11 Right-To-Know Law

Vendors supplying products or contracted to perform services for Carroll County Public Schools may have access to the Chemical Information List through the office of Facilities Operations. In addition, the Chemical Information List will be available at each school building office.

2-12 Policies of Employment

The contractor shall advise CCPS of the intention to use any employees that are hired or obtained from any penal pre-release or work-release programs. In the event such employees are used, notification to CCPS shall include name and violation for each individual. The contractor shall take reasonable precautions when selecting such individuals and provide whatever safeguards are necessary for effective supervision. Contractor's employees are not permitted inside school buildings when the nature of the contract is for outside work.

Potential contractors/vendors of Carroll County Public School are advised that Maryland law now provides the following mandatory restrictions on registered sex offenders performing work or services on school system property:

"A person who enters into a contract with a county board of education or a nonpublic school may not knowingly employ an individual to work at a school if the individual is a registrant. A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 5 years or a fine not exceeding \$5,000 or both."

Persons or entities awarded contracts with Carroll County Public Schools are required to certify that no employee, subcontractor, subcontractor employee, or material supplier that is a registered sex offender will be allowed to enter onto school system property at any time in the performance of the work or services for which the contract is awarded. Such certification is a condition precedent to any contract award, and failure to so certify will be grounds for not awarding a contract. It will be the responsibility of contractors to obtain similar certification from all sub-contractors and material suppliers performing work or services on school system property and to monitor adherence to this requirement. In the event that Carroll County Public Schools determines that a registered sex offender has entered upon school system property in the performance of work for a contractor/vendor, such will be grounds for termination of the contract.
